

## Instructions

You will need: One set of dominoes cards for each group of 4 students.

This works best when students are in teams – two against two, as there is more speaking, and the purpose of this is to get students trying to pronounce the sounds correctly.

### Procedure

- Shuffle the domino cards and deal out six to each team, then deal one face up.
- Students take it in turns to match one of their cards to the ones on the table.
- If they can't see a pair, they pick up another card and miss that turn.
- The winners are the first group to use up all their cards.

### Alternative procedure

- Deal out all the cards to the two teams.
- The first group to find a card where both sounds are the same starts (e.g. near and year) by putting their card down.
- Students then take it in turns to match one of their cards to the words on the table. If they make a mistake, they must take the card back and lose that turn.

If you are worried about the students' accuracy, you could give each group a referee with an answer sheet to check which words have the same pronunciation of 'ea'.

Feedback: while monitoring you could note mistakes to check. If you don't see any mistakes, then at the end just elicit 3-5 word pairs for each of the sounds.
